Supplemental Notice of Race (SNOR)

Date of Race: Saturday May 20, 2023

Rules and Management: Lake Shore Sail Club (LSSC) is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the LSSC Ice Breaker Regatta. This race will be governed by the DRYA 2023 Notice of Race (NOR) and Sailing Instructions (SIs) and the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024 (RRS), or as amended herein.

The Officers, Board of Directors, and Members of Lake Shore Sail Club are proud to announce the Second Annual LSSC Ice Breaker Regatta. This race will be a DRYA counter race and is the first Saturday Race of the DRYA calendar for 2023. The race is open to all boats registered for 2023 DRYA Counter Series races and to others by invitation. Members of DRYA clubs not registered to race with DRYA may register for this race by submitting an application found on the Lake Shore Sail Club website www.lakeshoresailclub.org. Boats must meet the class criteria as set forth by the DRYA for 2023 and as listed below. Applications must be submitted to the Race Chairman by 7pm, Tuesday May 16, 2023.

The **LSSC Ice Breaker Regatta** will be a standard DRYA Windward-Leeward Regatta. <u>Be</u> sure to read the DRYA Notice of Race (NOR) and DRYA Sailing Instructions (SIs) as they govern this regatta unless modified by LSSC. Be sure to review the LSSC Supplemental Sailing Instructions (SSIs) for those modifications to these standard instructions. NOTE: Where any conflicts arise between the race documents, the LSSC SSIs will govern.

The Classes and Class Splits will follow the DRYA Saturday Windward-Leeward Class Splits and Starts. Please refer to the DRYA NOR/SIs.

LSSC Boats: We invite all of our boats that are not racing in a standard DRYA Class to race in the CLUB JAM (NSHCP) Class. No fee shall be charged for registration. A 2023 MWPHRF Handicap Certificate shall be required to register.

Invited Boats: Boats from other Clubs not racing in a standard DRYA Class can enter the CLUB JAM (NSHCP) Class for a \$40 fee paid to DRYA at registration and with submittal of a 2023 MWPHRF Handicap Certificate. To enter, complete the application found on the Lake Shore Sail Club website www.lakeshoresailclub.org. Invited boats must also register for entry on the DRYA website by 7pm on Tuesday prior to the Sponsoring Club's regatta day.
